



**PROFESSOR ADEBAYO OLUKOSHI**, Director for the United Nations African Institute for Economic Development and Planning (IDEP) in Dakar, Senegal, will deliver a public lecture on the topic: **“Nuancing African Scholarship: The African Perspective”** at the Howard College Theatre, UKZN, Durban on 23 May 2012 at 17:30.

Professor Olukoshi graduated from the Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, Nigeria and Leeds University, England. Until March 2009, he was the Executive Secretary of the Council for Development of Social Science Research in Africa (CODESRIA). He has also previously served as Director of Research at the Nigerian Institute of International Affairs, Lagos, Nigeria and Programme Officer at the Nordiska Afrikainstitutet (NAI), Uppsala, Sweden.

He has published extensively on the politics of economic relations, governance and development.

Professor Olukoshi holds numerous academic honours and research fellowships and belongs to a number of professional associations such as the Nigerian Economic Society (NES), International Political Science Association (IPSA) and the Institute for African Alternatives (IFAA), London, England.

He has also undertaken research studies and consultancy for various organisations such as the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa, the World Bank, Ford Foundation, African Development Bank and UNDP.
